Sales Tables

If you are interested in having a vendor or display table please contact the auction convenor by email (canterburyauction2024@outlook.com) prior to Sunday September 22nd, 2024 to confirm availability (failing to confirm directly with the auction convenor by email will result in being not being able to secure a table). Vendor and display setup is on Friday evening with complete instructions being provided as part of your confirmation.

There is no charge for vendor or display tables, however as a free resource provided by the club it is expected that you will cooperate with event staff, others, and share a table with another vendor or move if requested.

Location

This is immediately west of the McLeans Island Steam Scene, the Chch Pistol Club, NZDA, and the Handloader's Ranges.


Entrance via the Vintage Car Club main gates, and follow the road south to the Hall. Parking is on the grass around the hall.

Entry and Registration

Registration and viewing starts at 8 am. The auction will commence at 11 am. A 30-minute break will be taken after lot 150.

\$10.00 entry fee applies to EVERYONE over the age of 18 entering the auction.

There will be food and non-alcoholic beverages available for purchase from the venue between 8 am and 2pm.

All buyers **MUST** be a current NZAHAA member or a member of an invited kindred club. The organisers reserve the right to refuse admittance to any individual. **Please bring evidence of club or kindred club membership.**

Those wishing to bid on items requiring a firearms license must have their license with them and available to be checked.

Conditions of Sale

Although every effort has been made to describe each lot accurately, no warranty is given, and neither is the Auctioneer, Auction Committee, NZ Antique & Historical Arms Association, Canterbury Branch Inc, or the vendor responsible for any lots or faults in any lots. No sale shall be invalid and no person shall have any claim against the Canterbury Auction or its staff because of faults or mis-descriptions. All descriptions of firearms and ammunition are for collector's guidance only and do not refer to their safety or suitability for use.

It is the buyer's and seller's responsibility to complete the necessary permits to procure endorsed items before the buyer can take possession of these items.

Collectable Items and Militaria

Due to the large number of reproductions, including some apparently made from "original" moulds and dies, no guarantee of authenticity can be given.

While items are catalogued with care, all purchasers, including postal bidders, must satisfy themselves as to the authenticity of any lot.

Payment & Buyers Premium

The buyer's premium is 10% and is payable on all purchases on the Hammer Price for items purchased through the auction (incl. postal bids) as well as on the realised price of items sold from passed in items. Buyers (including those bidding on behalf of others) are entering into a binding agreement to complete the purchase upon the fall of the auctioneer's hammer and are personally responsible for the payment for all items they have bid on. Bidders attending the auction will be required to pay for their purchases (including fees) during or at the conclusion of the auction by cash, EFTPOS or credit card.

In-person buyers will only be issued with a receipt to collect their items if they have made full payment (hammer price + premiums and fees) through the club. Paying the owner of the item directly will not result in release of won items.

All lots become the responsibility of the purchaser at the fall of the hammer and the Canterbury Branch of NZAHAA Inc takes no responsibility for any loss or damage incurred after that time.

Any disputes will be settled at the discretion of the Canterbury Branch Committee.

Please note: There is a 1.85% surcharge on all payments made by Credit Card (Mastercard and Visa only) and EFTPOS transactions at the venue.

If paying partially in cash and partially by credit or eftpos, the amount owed will be calculated based on a solely credit/EFT-POS sale.

We do not accept Cheques.

Buyer's procedure for items not requiring licenses for possession

1. Pay for items from auction front desk and receive paired receipts confirming payment.
2. Take both receipts to "Purchased Item Pickup" area.
3. Present both receipts to auction pickers for item retrieval.
4. Once all items have been received, sign both copies of receipts and leave one copy with the picker.
5. When leaving the premises, show your receipt and items to security.

Buyer's procedure for A-Category firearms and controlled items

1. Pay for items from auction front desk and receive paired receipts confirming payment.
2. Take both receipts to "Purchased Item Pickup" area.
3. Present both receipts and your firearms license to auction pickers for item retrieval.
4. Once all items have been received, sign both copies of receipts and leave one copy with the picker.
5. When leaving the premises, show your receipt and items to security.
 - a. Firearms may have to be wrapped prior to leaving the premises to avoid alarming the public.
6. Note: All firearms in this auction are registered. You will need to transfer your A-category firearms from the seller to your name in a timely manner following purchase. Transferring into your name can be done online or by calling the firearms safety authority. The Arms Officers on site are not able to assist with registration. Purchasing firearms will also initiate registration of your other firearms if you have not already done so.

Buyer's procedure for Endorsed firearms

1. Pay for items from auction front desk and receive paired receipts confirming payment.
 - a. If you have purchased endorsed items, ask the auction convenor for the name of the seller.
2. Find the seller (ask auction staff for help identifying the seller if required)
3. Go with the seller to the Police Arms Officer at the "Endorsed Items Transfers" area to initiate the transfer.
4. Present your receipts and firearms license to the Arms Officer.
 - a. Arms officer will begin the transfer process and pass your invoices to pickers for item retrieval.
5. Once all items have been received and the transfer approved by the Arms Officer, sign both copies of receipts and leave one copy with the picker.
6. When leaving the premises, show your receipt for payment and any relevant Permits to Possess to security.
 - a. Firearms may have to be wrapped prior to leaving the premises to avoid alarming the public.
7. Note: All firearms in this auction are registered. In addition to completing the permit to procure, you will also need to register your firearm online or by phone in a timely manner following purchase. Transferring into your name can be done online or by

calling the firearms safety authority. The Arms Officers on site are not able to assist with entering the firearm into the registry as this is a separate system. Purchasing firearms will also initiate registration of your other firearms if you have not already done so.

Procedure for Withdrawn Items

Buyers may purchase a withdrawn item at the vendor's reserve price or at the agreed price with the vendor.

1. The buyer of a withdrawn item will ask for the front desk staff to list the withdrawn item against their bat number.
 - a. In the event the vendor has agreed to sell the item for less than the listed reserve price, the vendor must accompany the buyer and present their ID to the auction front desk before this price can be entered in the system.
2. Following the item being listed against the buyer's bat number, the purchase process will follow the uncontrolled, A-Category, or Endorsed Item purchase processes.

Payment for withdrawn items must be made via the auction front desk. Paying the owner of the item directly will not result in release of won items.

Buyer's procedure for Sales Table items

1. Sales table seller provides receipt for purchased items.
2. When leaving the premises, show your receipt and items to security.
 - a. Firearms may have to be wrapped prior to leaving the premises to avoid alarming the public.

Successful postal bidders will be notified within one week of auction conclusion by email with an included invoice for amount owed (inclusive of item cost, buyer's premium, shipping and packaging charges). If email is not available, the buyer will be contacted by phone. Unsuccessful bids will not be notified. Failing payment of the invoiced amount within one week of the invoice being sent, the buyer's rights will be forfeited.

Please Note:

1. Postal bids will be noted in order of receipt and if identical bids are received, the bid that arrived first will take precedence.
2. The postal bidding form must be filled out entirely and **legibly** or may be rejected. If you have crossed out, written over, or smudged your form, please consider re-writing it. We are frequently unable to read forms because of this.
3. Postal bids are only permitted from current NZAHAA or kindred club members.
4. **Powder, primers, live ammunition, and inert ordnance cannot be shipped.** Postal bidders of the above items must arrange their own pickup and transport of these items, with pickup of items within two weeks of receiving their invoice.
5. Bids on powder, primers, live ammunition, and inert ordnance must indicate below how the items will be picked up on their form below, otherwise the bid will not be entered.
6. All firearms are now subject to registration. Bidders must show evidence of transfer of firearms onto their license before firearms will be shipped or released to postal bidder representatives.
7. Only bids fully completed on this form (or a photocopy) and duly signed will be accepted.
8. All bids are in NZ dollars.
9. Bids for controlled items (firearms, endorsed items, and ammunition) will only be accepted if they match the bidder's endorsement categories, these endorsements are properly listed on this form, and the licence is current.
10. Bidders will be made aware of their success as soon as practical after the auction.

11. Unsuccessful bids will not be advised.
12. Firearms shipping cost depends on the item being shipped and shipping method used:
 - i. Long guns North Island: \$95/firearm
 - ii. Long Guns South Island: \$80/firearm
 - iii. Small Pistols N & S Island: \$60/case
- b. Pistols are required to be shipped in a locked case: \$35/case
- c. All firearms are required to be shipped with a trigger lock. Lock cost to be calculated on purchase.

13. Non-controlled item shipping will be calculated upon completion of the auction.

Payment

The only method of payment available for postal bidders is direct credit (online banking). The Branch bank account details will be provided on invoices to successful bidders.

Shipping of Firearms.

Under the 1983 arms act, all shipping of firearms, major parts (determined by the arms office) and ammunition require the buyer to complete a mail order form (FRM43a) and submit it to an Arms officer for approval. Shipping will only occur following Arms Officer approval.

An alternative option for buyers is to arrange for an in-person attendee to buy on your behalf and uplift your items under the provisions of their own license.

All firearms now require transfer between the buyer, seller, and police. Easiest option is to do this at the same time as the mail order form by accessing the Firearms Safety Authority web portal or phoning their assistance line.

Additional Shipping Information:

1. **For non-firearm items** please use your home or work address to enable courier delivery during normal working hours.
 - a. Your listed postal address cannot be a PO Box number, as Couriers will not accept parcels for delivery to PO Boxes.
2. **For Firearms and endorsed items** please provide the address of your nearest Firearms Dealer who has confirmed their willingness to receive the firearms.
 - a. Alternatively provide your nearest Mainfreight depot if you are able to pick up from that depot.
3. Costs for freight may vary dependant on who you use as the receiving Dealer.
4. Items are shipped at the purchaser's risk. We suggest arranging insurance for your items.
